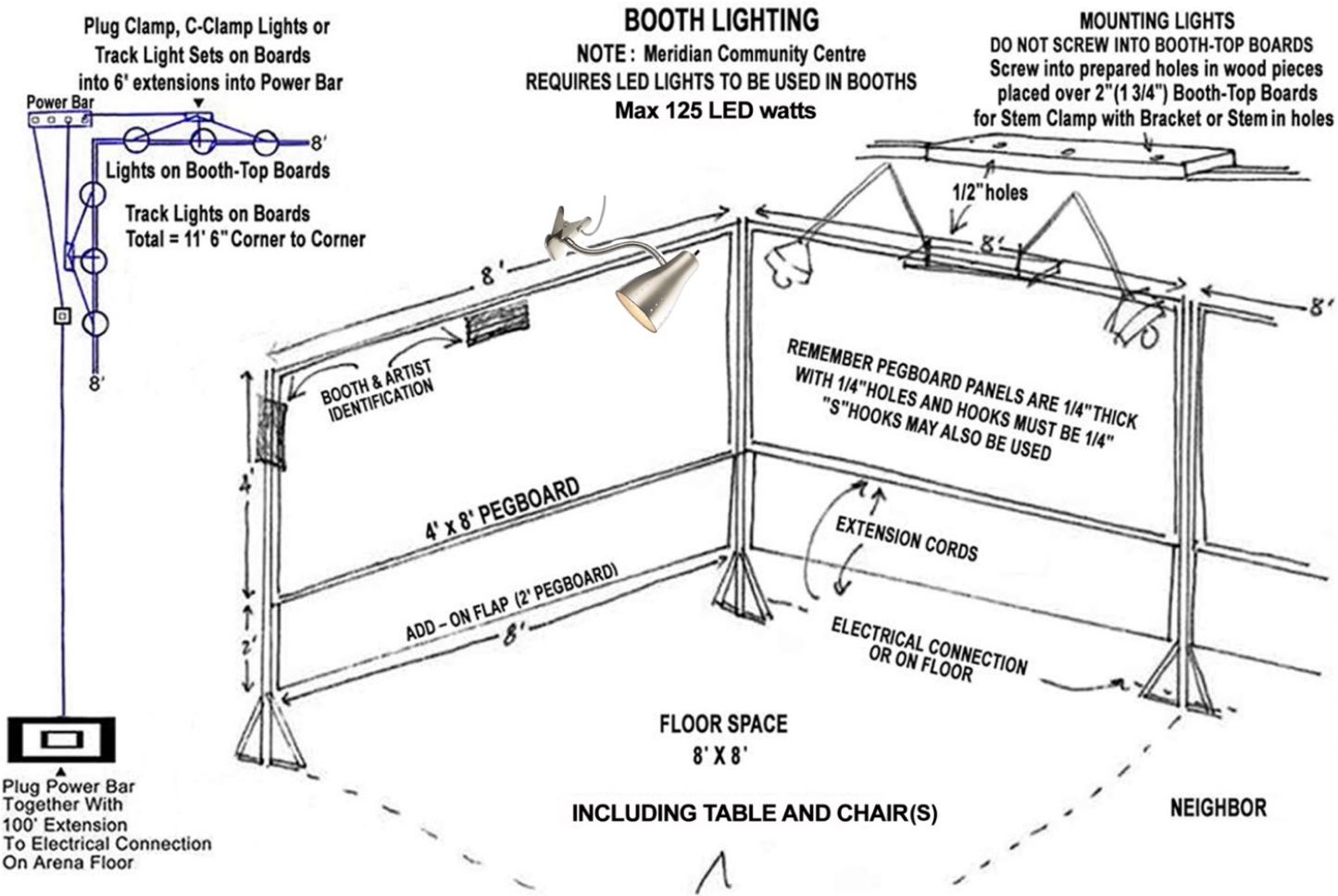


ARTIST BOOTH LIGHTING 2026 PELHAM ART FESTIVAL

LED LIGHTING – ARTIST DIRECTIONS

To ensure a smooth and well-lit festival experience, please review the following lighting requirements and setup information.

Lighting Requirement:

All artist booth lighting must be **LED**, with no exceptions. This requirement is set by the **Meridian Community Centre** to prevent electrical overloads that caused blackouts in previous years. LED lighting is energy-efficient, bright, and readily available.

Festival Lighting Conditions:

To allow the focus to be on your art, the **arena overhead lights will be dimmed on Friday Opening Night**, and again on **Saturday and Sunday during festival hours**, while **entry hallways will remain fully lit** for safe visibility.

Power Access:

- Central electrical panels will be available for artist use.
- Please bring a **50 to 100-foot, 3-prong extension cord** to reach the panels.
- A **stepladder** is recommended for positioning your booth lights above pegboard tops.

Booth Setup Guidelines:

- Do **not drill** into booth pegboards.
- At the end of the Festival, please **remove all tape, sticky tack, staples, and other materials** from the pegboards before leaving.

Inspection & Setup Timing:

- Artists must have booth lighting installed by **4:00 PM Friday** for the **Town Electrical Inspection**.
- Lighting will be **professionally balanced** after inspection.
- Please **do not make any lighting changes** once inspection is complete.
